If there is anyone present who has just cause why this couple should not be united, I mean really, why did you come? Go Home.

Who give this woman to this man? (I and my family)

Beloved Friends and Family, please be seated.

Before we get started with our Ceremony here today, I would like to start with this:

The words contained in the Ceremony & Vows that you will hear today have been chosen very carefully. We not only speak these words as being symbolic of the commitment we make, but also to keep them in our hearts as a reminder of the covenant or promise that we have pledged here today. (GROOM) & (BRIDE), as the years go by, may you find that the vows that you have spoken today and words contained herein, have a richer & deeper meaning to both of you. My Prayer for the both of you is that God grants you the wisdom and confidence in making the right decisions, for your lives together as well as for your children.

(Page One)

Beloved Family & Friends, as God the Father through His Son Jesus Christ has ordained your servant with the trust of the Gospel and the servitude to perform Marriage Rites, I must tell you that it is not I that marries. You enter into this covenant of marriage together with God in the center, as the scripture reads in Gen 2:24 & Matt 19:5, "therefore a man shall leave his father and mother and be joined to his wife, and they shall become one flesh." The joining OR marriage of a man & woman is ordained and created of God.

Therefore, Beloved Family & Friends I ask that you pray for (GROOM) & (BRIDE), as well as their children, to hold them up in prayer, to help them in a time of need, and to ask our Heavenly Father thru Jesus that He would strengthen their hearts and keep them healthy in body and in spirit.

Furthermore, Beloved Friend & Family, those married couples that are here today, witnessing the joining of (GROOM) & (BRIDE) in Holy Matrimony, I want you to pay close attention. I don't care if you were married 60 years or 60 seconds ago, I would like you to participate in our Ceremony today. How many here today know that Marriage is NOT a spectator sport. There's no sitting on the sidelines. Oh no, you have to work at it. What does that mean? Well, you can't even begin to work at something unless we have an understanding of it, which means you have to LISTEN first. Married Guys pay attention. Here's how: Eph 5:23 says "For the husband is the head of the wife, as also Christ is head of the Church...and HE is the Savior of the body". This doesn't mean you get to boss you wife around. Probably for some of you, it's the other way around. The key word here is AS Christ is head of the Church, the body of believers. What does Christ do for us? He reconciles us to God the Father. In the same way, men, lead your wife's AND your children to the Father thru Jesus. Scriptually, that puts a big resposibility on a married man to act as a spiritual leader. So, as you are called here to be a part of the joining of (GROOM) & (BRIDE). I want you to hold the hand of your wife throughout this Ceremony and repeat the vows that our Bride & Groom speak to each other, reconfirming the commitment and coventant that you have made to one another.

My prayer for all married couple here today is that is found in 1 COR 7:3 "Let the husband render to his wife the affection due her, and likewise also the wife to her husband".

(BRIDE) and (GROOM), marriage is the most important of all earthly relationships. It should be entered into reverently, thoughtfully and with full understanding of its sacred nature. Your marriage must stand by the strength of your love and the power of the faith in each other and in God. Just as two threads woven in opposite directions form a beautiful tapestry, so to are your lives when merged together, will make a beautiful marriage.

1 Corinthians 13:4 (Paraphrased)

RING EXCHANGE (Who has the rings?)

The ring is a symbol of the unbroken circle of love. Love freely given has no beginning and no end, no giver and no receiver for each is the giver and each is the receiver. May these rings always remind you of the vows you have spoken here today.

(Repeat after me)
